

Permanon Application and Maintenance Guide Automotive

Surface Preparation for Used & New Vehicles

All Vehicles will require the surface to be cleaned and free from wax prior to the application of Permanon Supershine. For the best results we recommend Permanon cleaning products. First use Permanon Hecta to remove organic contamination such as road tar, bird droppings, tree sap, etc. Permanon Hecta can also be used as a lubricant when using a clay bar, this will remove all surface contamination and leave a silky smooth surface. Use Permanon Omega as a final rinse to neutralize the surface prior to the application of Permanon Supershine.

It is important to note that if wax has been recently applied to the surface it should then be removed prior to the application of Permanon as Permanon will adhere to the wax and not the surface. To remove wax and contamination use Permanon Hecta with a clay bar.

Permanon Supershine can be applied to all hard surfaces, paintwork, glass, plastic trim, chrome trim, metal, alloy wheels etc. One application will last up to eight months when applied undiluted, as a guide the application of Permanon Supershine on an average size car will ONLY COST YOU AROUND £2.00 AND 5-10 MINUTES OF YOUR TIME.

How to Apply Permanon Supershine & Super-Matt For Best Results and Durability

Part fill a small spray bottle with undiluted Supershine, then lightly mist a microfiber cloth or mitt and wipe the surface of the vehicle then dry with a microfiber cloth to remove any residue. You can also remove any residue by washing the car with fresh water then dry with a microfiber cloth to prevent any hard water marks. If using filtered water there is no need to dry the vehicle.

Maintenance

After the first application of Permanon you will notice the surface is extremely hydrophobic and water will easily run off or bead. This beading indicates the coating is working and repelling water and dirt as well as maintaining a good level of gloss and UV protection. It is important that the vehicle be washed when required, this of course depends on mileage.

To wash vehicle just use water and wash by hand or use a pressure washer. A good quality ph. balanced shampoo can also be used if required. We recommend Permanon 2 in 1 shampoo.

Permanon will require a top up when required, as this only takes a few minutes and will maintain maximum protection. Mix with water at 10% for a quick detail.

DO NOT USE a wash and wax or any cleaner that has any wax in it. DO NOT USE washing up liquid or any harsh chemical cleaners.
